My design project, 'Moyes Studios', aims to provide a platform for the youth of BWFE to break away from the negative stereotype and progress out of the estate. The program of music is already present among the estate youth, and 'Moyes Studios' aims to provide the space and tools necessary for their hobby to become a potential career path.

My dissertation, titled 'The Oxmoor: Social Politics in Design and How Architecture Can Divide Communities' explored how the architecture of London Overspill estates can reflect social divides between itself and the pre-existing local community. With an underlying structure following my mum's life growing up and out of the estate, personal accounts enabled a first-hand perspective of life there. It also highlighted the diminishing character in ever-developing communities like ours in Cambridgeshire.
